Due to ongoing issues experienced during nightly meetings and repeated instances of unruliness, we find it necessary to make a decision that ensures the safety and well-being of all our members. These disturbances have increasingly affected our ability to maintain the conducive atmosphere our members expect and deserve.

After careful consideration and multiple discussions, the Board of Directors has unanimously decided to adjust our hours of operation. Effective May 28th, the Alano Club will close each night at 7:30 PM until further notice. Any meetings that normally meet outside of 7:30 pm will no longer be allowed to meet at the Alano Club. This change is essential to manage the current challenges effectively and continue providing a supportive recovery environment.

We understand that this decision may affect your daily routines and access to meetings during the evenings. We encourage you to take full advantage of the meetings available during our operational hours.

We are committed to revisiting this decision regularly and will keep you updated with any changes. Our priority remains your safety and the integrity of the recovery space we have built together. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in these challenging times.
